The bronze medal minted in 2014 features Ferdinand Porsche, one of the most important automotive engineers in history. The medal features the Type 64 Porsche that laid the foundation for the later success of the Porsche sports car manufacturer.



This coin is the second of three of Canada's Sky Wonders, the naturally occurring optical illusion. The reverse design is a night time scene in early fall and the neon colours of the aurora borealis are enhanced under black light.



The Mint of Poland presents a commemorative coin collection featuring precious clocks created in the atelier of Peter Carl Fabergé. The artwork has been created from ivory, emerald guilloché, gold and silver.



The fourth coin of the series "The Labyrinths of the World" issued in cooperation with the Central Bank of Armenia. The obverse of the coin depicts the Masone labyrinth and the pyramid shaped chapel.

2020 heralds the Year of the Rat in the Chinese almanac calendar. The Monetary Authority of Singapore presents the fourth issue in the ongoing Singapore Chinese Almanac Coin Series (2017 - 2028).



The Adele Bloch Portrait is a one-in-five coin series of Klimt's Women Collection. A portrait of the Austrian artist himself is reproduced on the coin's obverse.

The 5 oz silver coin minted in 2019 marks the 130th anniversary of the Eiffel Tower. The obverse shows an aerial view by night of the Eiffel Tower, with gold deposits creating the plunging light beams on the city.



The third gold coin from the Czech Mint's miniseries which has been issued on the occasion of the 85th birthday of Ferda the Ant, a children's animated series based on the Ferda Mravenec picture books by Czech author Ondrej Sekora.
